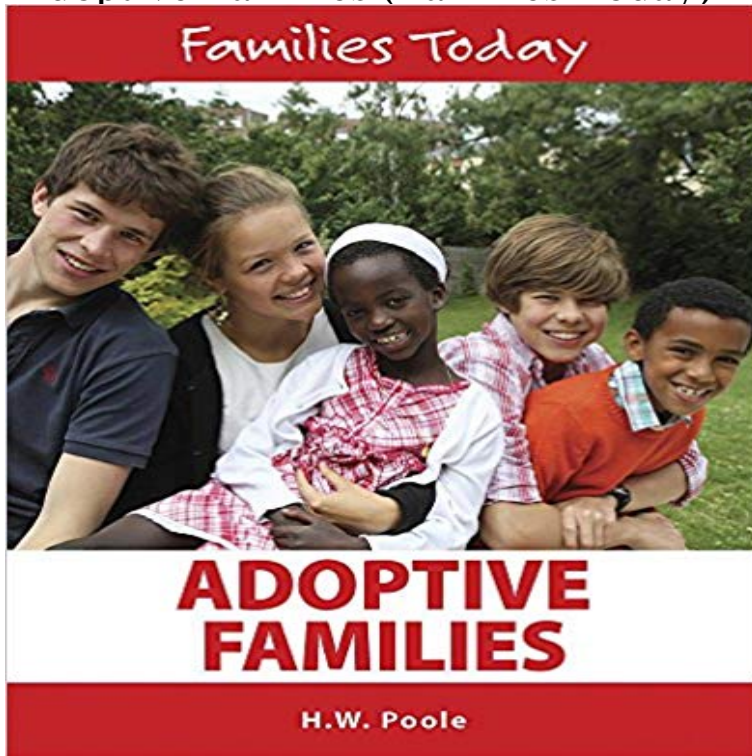


Adoptive Families (Families Today)
