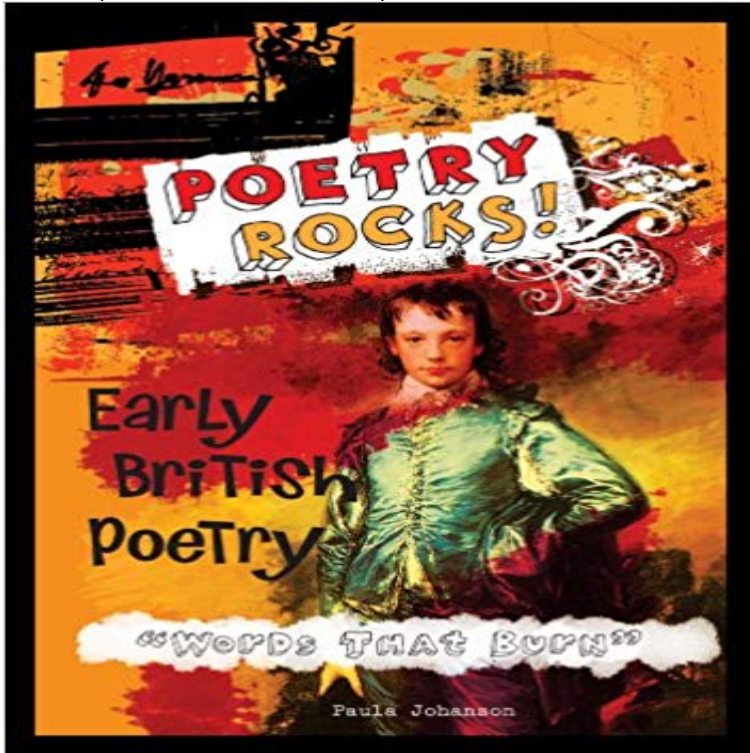


Early British Poetry: Words That Burn (Poetry Rocks!)
