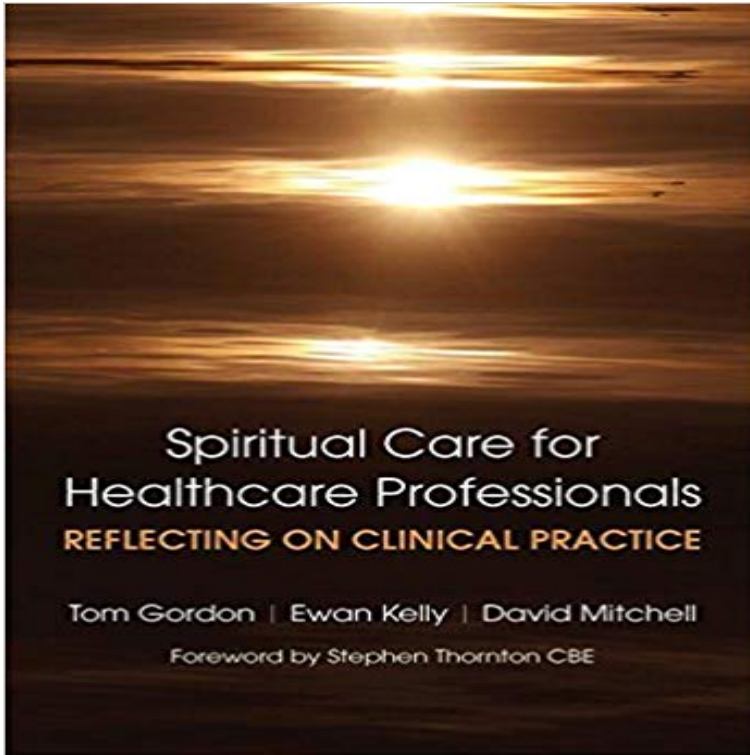


Reflecting on Clinical Practice Spiritual Care for Healthcare Professionals
