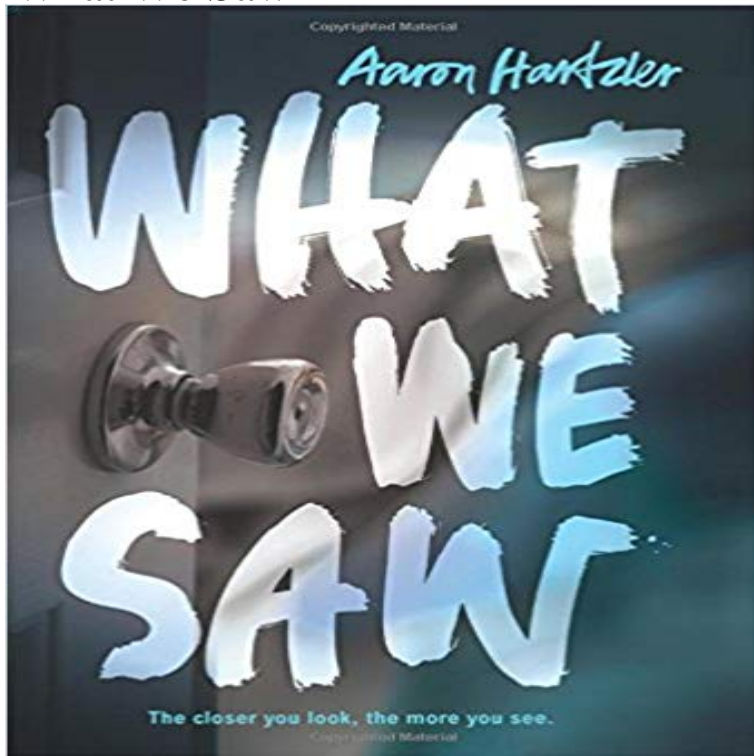


What We Saw
